The CAIR Award is awarded annually to an individual or individuals for distinguished and extraordinary service to the Canadian Association for Interventional Radiology and/or the discipline of Interventional Radiology.

Service to Interventional Radiology may include teaching, basic research, clinical investigation, radiologic statesmanship, and/or promotion of Interventional Radiology or CAIR. Research must be recognized for quality and consistency by publication in recognized professional journals. Service to CAIR may include outstanding contributions to CAIR, other medical organizations, and/or government agencies. The CAIR Award may also be bestowed upon individuals who have dedicated their past and present talents to advancing the quality of patient care through the practice of Interventional Radiology, and/or who, by their outstanding achievements, also help to ensure the future of the field.



2020 - DR. LINDSAY MACHAN, MD, FSIR

Dr. Lindsay Machan is an interventional radiologist at the Vancouver Hospital, a CIRSE Distinguished Fellow, SIR Fellow and an Asia Pacific Society of Interventional Radiology Honorary Member.

In 2006, he shared the Manning Innovation Principle Award for the development of the paclitaxel eluting stent. He has co-edited the last three editions of Krishna Kandarpa's *Handbook of Interventional Radiologic Procedures*. He frequently presents at M&M conferences.



2021 - DR. GILLES SOULEZ, MD, MSc, FRCPC, FSIR

Dr. Gilles Soulez MD, MSc, FSIR is a vascular and interventional radiologist at CHUM, University of Montréal. He completed his radiology residency in France at University Paris V in 1988 and completed a 2-year fellowship combined with a certification of the French College of Interventional Radiology. He completed a MSc in clinical research and epidemiology at University of Montreal in 2000 and obtained a clinical researcher scholarship from the FRQ-S from the Junior I to National Scientist award.

He is currently appointed as a Professor of Radiology at University of Montreal and was chairman of the Department of Radiology, Radiation-Oncology and Nuclear Medicine from 2012 to 2020. His research is dedicated to the advancement of vascular and interventional radiology in the field of aortic, peripheral arterial diseases and management of vascular anomalies. He is funded by the Canadian Fund of Innovation, Canadian Institute of Health Research, Natural Science and Engineering Research Council, Fonds de la Recherche en Santé du Québec (FRQ-S). He has published 210 peer-reviewed papers during his career (H index 45). He has authored and co-authored nine patents and is very active in technological transfer with leading companies in this field, such as, Siemens Medical and Cook Medical.

DR. AFSHIN GANGI, MD, PHD
University Hospital of Strasbourg | Strasbourg, France

Dr. Afshin Gangi graduated from the Medical School of the University Hospital of Reims (France). After his residency at the University of Strasbourg in radiology, he specialized in interventional radiology and obtained his Master of Science in medical biology and his PhD in laser physics. He is a Professor of radiology since 2000 at the University Hospital of Strasbourg. He is an invited Professor at King's College London.

Since 2007, Afshin Gangi has been the Chairman of Radiology and Nuclear Medicine at the University Hospital of Strasbourg. He is an Interventional Radiologist, specializing in oncology, MSK and the spine. He is currently responsible for the department of Interventional Radiology at the University Hospital of Strasbourg. He has published over 200 scientific papers, contributed to 40 books, and presented more than 470 lectures and scientific papers.

He is a member of several societies: CIRSE (Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe), RSNA (Radiological Society of North America), ECR (European Congress of Radiology), SIR (Society of Interventional Radiology), ASSR (American Society of Spine Radiology), ARRS (American Roentgen Ray Society), SFR (Société Française de Radiologie), member of the National Academy of Surgery, elected President of CIRSE and deputy Chairman of ECIO.



DR. LAURA FINDEISS, MD, FSIR, FAHA

Dr. Laura Findeiss is a Vascular and Interventional Radiologist who is committed to the pursuit of systems of care that support quality outcomes and patient and provider satisfaction. Her focus is on multidisciplinary care, emphasizing multispecialty collaboration, teamwork, and operational efficiency and standardization. She places an emphasis on the role of the radiologist as a consultant member of the patient care team and has worked to create structures that support the consultative practice of radiology. Her clinical and academic interests include peripheral arterial disease, vascular anomalies, and rural health care

disparities. She is a past president of the Society of Interventional Radiology and is currently Chief of Radiology at Grady Memorial Hospital and Professor of Radiology and Surgery at Emory University School of Medicine.



DR. PASCAL CHABROT, MD, PHD, FE-CIRSE
Radiology CHU Clermont-Fd | Clermont-Ferrand, France

Interventional Radiologist (2004) and Professor of Radiology (2013) in the Imaging Department of the University Hospital of Clermont-Ferrand, France (Pr Boyer) after a residency in Clermont and Paris and a fellowship in Montreal (2008-09). In charge of the experimental cath lab for a research team dedicated to endovascular treatment in oncologic and endovascular IR (pharmacokinetic of cisplatin in TACE in animal model, echo-endoscopic creation of portosystemic shunt in animal model, bi-embolization of portal and hepatic vein in an animal model). Has led the Interventional Unit since 2018 and the Radiology Department

of CHU Montpied since January 2022.

Member of the endovascular sub-committee of the European Society of Radiology since 2017; Member of the endovascular sub-committee of the CIRSE since 2018; Correspondent for IR in the French College of Radiology Teachers since 2019; President of the French Society of Cardio-Vascular Imaging since 2020.
